Topics are based on the core content areas identified in the EM Model and include Endocrine, Metabolic, and Nutritional Disorders; Head, Ear, Eye, Nose, Throat Disorders; Renal and Urogenital Disorders; Hematologic Disorders; Systemic Infectious Disorders; Nervous System Disorders; Cardiovascular Disorders; and more. At the conclusion of the course, participants will be able to apply the clinical and practical review points of the ABEM LLSA readings as they prepare for their LLSA test.

To take the exam onsite, you must have your ABEM User ID and Password with you to access the ABEM website. Physicians must register for the CME activity when they register for the LLSA exam and before taking the LLSA exam. The LLSA exam fee is \$100.
