At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

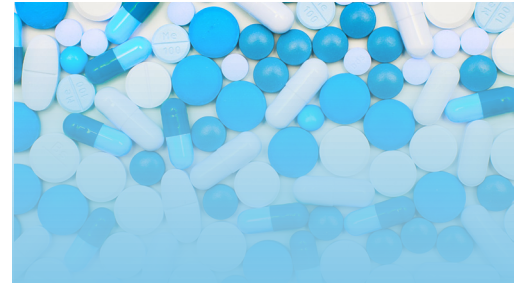
- Review addiction identification and evidence-based treatments.
