**Target Audience and Eligibility:** Illinois prescribers with a valid state medical license and DEA registration number can register for an X-waiver without mandatory training. This training is for Illinois prescribers who may care for patients with co-occurring opioid use disorder including hospitalists, emergency medicine clinicians, family medicine clinicians, obstetrics/gynecology, midwifery, internal medicine, urgent care clinicians, etc. This includes the following professionals: MD, DO, PA, APRN, NO, CNS, CRNA, CNM.
